Keeping the Competitive Edge ...



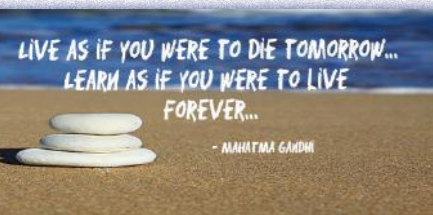

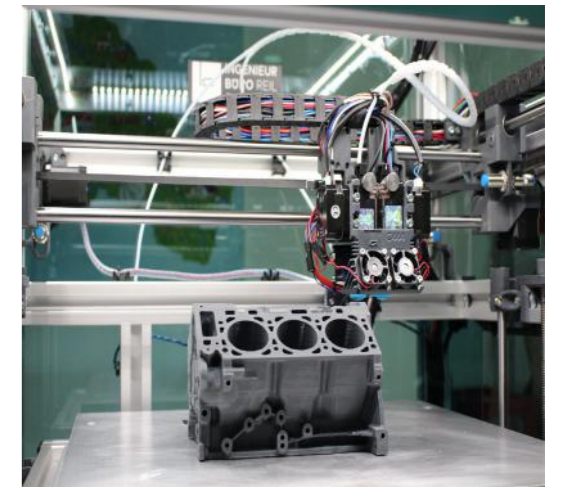
